The board reviewed the current Tarkio Resource Center Resource Policy and will continue to discuss to make needed changes and updates.

Director's Report- Jennifer Roup reported that she wrote a LOI for the Patterson Family Grant. She also reported on the status of the CDBG Demolition Grant. The city of Rock Port published the bids for demolition and asbestos inspection services. Jerri Dearmont told Jennifer that the actually demolition bids would likely be completed over the summer. The current possible rental property has been inspected by the board members and we hope to be able to move into that facility if it is still available when we are ready to more.
