

ALMA PUBLIC LIBRARY Simple Bird Kite


MATERIALS:

- 18.5" x 11" piece of paper
- Construction paper to create beak and tail feathers
- Stapler
- Glue
- Hole punch
- String

Optional: Markers

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Fold the piece of paper in half "hamburger style". Gently fold edges up to create curved wings. Staple to secure.



- 2. Cut a triangle out of construction paper and glue to front of kite to form a beak. Cut feathers and glue to tail. If desired, draw on an eye and color as you wish.
- 3. Punch a hole in the body behind the staple. Tie string through hole. You're ready to fly!
