Shaping of Mckell Branch

Just a few short years after the demonstration of Library services provided by the Kentucky Department of Library's, the Greenup County Public Library system gained a branch in South Shore that would provide services to the Western area of the County. In 1973, the South Shore Library began but quickly outgrew the storefront on Main. In 1977, the Library moved to James Hannah Dr. and later incorporated the building next-door where it operated for 21 years. In 1998, the new library was built on land donated by the Greenup County Board of Education with the blessing and consent of the late Estell C. Mckell. At its present location, the Library has continued to be a valued resource. In 2018, the branch expanded to make room for more programming and other needs of the community.
