Stanley Ramey Honored

AARP and the IRS presented an award to Stan Ramey for 30 years of voluntary service for an IRS tax preparation program they sponsor. Stan is 92 years old and a resident of Wurtland. After retiring as principal of Wurtland and Fairview school, his volunteer work was one of his many "jobs." Early training for the AARP program in 1985 with Will Haas in Ashland was his start. Stan says that former director Dorothy Griffith supported the program as it became available in Greenup County and previously all three branches were often sites for the volunteers. Over the years the number of volunteers decreased so that only one site is now available and is located at the Greenup branch. Stan began teaching in Pulaskie County before he came home to Greenup County in 1955 when nine new schools were built. Thank you, Stan!
