## Program Descriptions

**Growing Readers-** A program for children ages three to six. Each week we will learn and practice early-literacy skills. We will have stories, hands-on literacy technology, crafts, and fun in this early-literacy program.

**Millersville Make or Do -** A free program where anyone may participate in making a craft or doing a fun activity. We look forward to seeing you here.

**Seed Exchange Workshop -** Visit the library to receive useful information about starting a flowerbed or small vegetable garden. Library card holders will be able to borrow seeds from the library and return seeds to the library at the end of the growing season. We would be happy for you to join our new exchange program.
